Rules & Regulations for BW's Choreography Competition 2025

ENTRY

- 1. Entry forms must be completed via our google doc by Sunday 12th October 2025. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 1. The competition is only open to students from **BW Dance Works**.
- 2. Competitors can only make a maximum of 2 entries. Each entry is £8 each.
- 3. Our show this year is 'Jet Set.' Please think about appropriate routines and songs for an 'Around the World' theme when deciding.
- 4. Duets, Trios and Quads will be in an age-group based on their oldest dancer.

CHOREOGRAPHY

- 1. Dancers must not use direct choreography from videos online.
- 2. Dancers must not use direct choreography from teachers.
- 3. Whilst all BW teachers wish to encourage everyone who enters, we cannot 'help' students with choreogrpahy but can give advise regarding costume, music and style of dance.

TIME LIMITS / MUSIC

- 1. Dances in all age groups must not exceed 1 minute 30 seconds. The music may be stopped should it exceed the time limit, or points deducted from our judges.
- 2. Music must be cut to the correct length and sent in 2 weeks advance of the competition day. If you need help cutting music, please get in touch with <u>bethanyebwdanceworks.com</u>.
- 3. Music must not contain explicit or suggestive lyrics. Parents must check their child's music before the competition. Music may be stopped if it is considered inappropriate.
- 4. Our show this year is 'Jet Set.' Please think about appropriate routines and songs for an 'Around the World Theme' when deciding.
- 5. Please see list of songs that are our of use as they are already in our line up for our show.

COSTUME AND APPEARANCE

- 1. Competitors should be properly attired and groomed for dancing with appropriate footwear and hairstyle. Elaborate costumes are not required.
- 2. Costumes should be age appropriate and cover underwear.
- 3. Props are allowed but must be safely cleared from the floor after your performance.
- 4. In the interest of safety, competitors should not attempt tricks which they have not been trained to perform.
- 5. Costumes can be hired from the 'BW Costume Store' on a first come, first serve basis at the rate of £5.50 per costume. Alternatively, there are many dance costume websites where you can buy your own or even just on amazon/ebay you can find lots. You don't have to buy anything expensive or extravagant.

PHOTOGRAPHY / RECORDING

- 1. Parents are allowed to photograph or video their own children but must not stand on the dance floor or distract the dancers or judges. Absolutely NO flash photography.
- 2.BW Dance Works will photograph and video competitors. Photos may be used on social media / for publicity if we have permission on your class4kids profile.

JUDGING / PRESENTATION OF PRIZES

- 1. Routines are judged on Technique / Content / Performance.
- 2. Certificates will be presented to every competitor at the end of each dance section.
- 3. All competitors are expected to stay to the end of the competition for the prize giving and to congratulate other competitors.
- 4. The independent adjudicators' decision is final. Additional or joint medals may be presented in sections at the discretion of the judging panel.
- 5. The overall winner will perform their choreography in our annual show on 14th of March 2026.
- 6. All competitors and audience members must show courtesy, encouragement, support and respect to all the other competitors and their friends/family.
